Perth's new and iconic Optus stadium project consisted of over 12,500 signs

Perth's newest entertainment venue

The Perth Stadium signage job was put out to tender in 2015 and the team at Kingman were very excited to have won the contract and to be the selected signage contractors for this mega project. The big K family are very proud to have been involved in yet another iconic architectural project.

The stadium consists of multi-levels and has the capacity to hold over 60,000 people making it the third largest stadium in Australia.

Kingman was responsible for the design, manufacture and installation of over 12,500 signs for this project. This signage package consisted of all the directional wayfinding signs, all the statutory signs and all the memorabilia signage internally and externally.

Impressive signage package completed at the Newest and largest bar in Perth

Contemporary creation

Kingman completed all of the internal and external signs for Perth's trendiest new bar, located 65 metres from the Optus Stadium in Burswood. The end result is a very sophisticated mix of contemporary and industrial features. It showcases exposed neon, quirky prints, wooden and perforated steel textures throughout the directional way-finding, statutory, wall graphics and external building signage. The whole project was completed in little over a month and has made Kingman very proud to have been a part of yet another exciting new development in WA.


This project consisted of more than 1900 signs and the standard of finish is incredibly high. We think this building has the highest quality of signage Perth has seen this decade.

Perth Airport T1 Domestic & T1 International, entry statement illuminated pylons



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
Iconic Entry Statement

Kingman have been working closely with Perth airport for many years and we continue to build our relationship with continuous support and signage solutions for a variety of sectors from all around Perth's airport.

When the redevelopment of Perth's airport was completed back in 2014 the only thing that was missing was an iconic entry statement in the form of illuminated signage pylons to identify T1 Domestic and T1 International Terminals.

Kingman Visual were awarded the contract to design the iconic totem pylon signs that tens of millions of travellers will enjoy in the years to come. Dozens of concept drawings were presented and the final design was narrowed down to a simplistic but stunning combination of glass, stainless steel, aluminium and illumination.

This project actually won Kingman an award at the biennial sign and graphics awards in 2016 for our very first design category entry. We are very proud to be the signage contractors for such a gorgeous project.



BANKWEST

The iconic signage for Perth's flagship store in Raine Square

Statement signage making an impact

2011 & 2012 saw Kingman complete over 70 stores for the Bankwest rebrand. This was finalised with completing the flagship store in Raine Plaza, Perth. The Raine Plaza site also resulted in a Gold Award for the team at Kingman at the biennial sign and graphics awards for a Major Fabrication entry.

The flagship store in Raine Square had a stunning illuminated branding logo manufactured and installed to the ceiling internally as an entry statement piece, with similar styled illuminated logo's installed externally to curved corners. This highly sophisticated method of curved joins was achieved from bending the Acrylic and ACM to make the ribbon appear seamless. This illuminated logo looks stunning against the corporate orange panelling.

During this period, we worked closely with both the project managers, builders and marketing co-ordinators to ensure each project was completed on time.

Kingman Visual continues to work with BankWest on a regular basis and maintain our long standing business relationship by continuously providing excellent signage.



PERTH BUSPORT

2016 saw some big and impressive projects, and the new Perth Busport was one of them.

Directional & Wayfinding

This project consisted of all the wayfinding and statutory signage for the new Perth Busport. Contracted by the City Busport Alliance, Kingman were tasked to manufacture and install the signage that is used throughout the tunnels, underground bus station and entry portals at ground level.

This project included working very closely with other trades throughout the entire project. Some of our signage included building very large housings for digital TV screens which were installed by the electrical contractor. It is a testament to our steel fabrication team that all AV elements fit within our signage first time.

Our in house signage designers reviewed and modified the existing drawings to include elements that satisfied the client's requirements while ensuring they are functional for long term use.



DOG SWAMP

The new Aldi shopping centre in Yokine has joined in on the latest trend of large scale street art



Street Art Signage

Towards the end of 2017, Kingman completed the signage rebrand of Dog Swamp's new Aldi shopping complex in Yokine WA.

This job was more than just sign writing, it was two pieces of large scale street art. On one wall, there is a duck which is 7 metres wide X 5 metres high, and on the other wall there is a dog which is 5 metres wide X 5 metres high. The project was painted by one of our talented sign writers who has been in the industry for over 37 years and is now our 3D on screen artist in the design department, however for this project he was persuaded to get the brushes out again and put his creative talents to good use!



MASTERS

Digitally printed large scale branding, to fire resistant composite panelling at Masters Dairy, Seven Oaks, Bentley



Large scale digital printing

This project consisted of a large scale (42metres W X 7metres H) image digitally printed directly to fire resistant composite panelling and then installed to the new extension at the Master's Milk facility located at Seven Oaks in Bentley.

This installation project was like a large scale jigsaw to put together.

The client was extremely happy with the final result and the image has brightened up the industrial look of the facility and is attracting a well-deserved marketing opportunity from passing traffic on the main road.




WESTPAC

Kingman were the chosen signage contractors for the new Westpac head offices in Perth's CBD

Signage sophistication

This project saw Kingman manufacture and install all the internal directional wayfinding and statutory signage for this highly sophisticated new office fit out. Kingman was also responsible for the internal privacy glazing films and a huge variety of vinyl decals throughout the offices, everything from locker numbers to bin decals in the staff kitchenette Kingman made and installed.

The directional wayfinding signs were all made with beautiful jarrah frames and aluminium inserts with router cut acrylic icons and lettering applied to face to create a raised effect. This is far from the standard off the shelf design usually seen in public facilities. These signs were all custom made with a slick and sophisticated theme carried throughout the interior of this trendy new office space.

Growing old in style

Kingman Visual were responsible for the signage package at the new aged care facility, Bethanie Group in Gwelup.

Kingman were tasked with a brief to come up with some design concepts for the entry signage to suit the architectural entry structure, and a directional wayfinding signage package to compliment the interior designer's colour scheme. Kingman provided the client with a signage style guide from which they then moved on to create a variety of design styles, which would eventually be assigned to different sections of the facility.

Our design team put forward some creative sketches that ended up winning us the entire signage contract for the project.

Kingman worked closely with PACT as they were the builders on the project and they made sure the whole process was run with extreme efficiency. Kingman also worked closely with our clients from Bethanie Group to ensure the entire project was meeting all the signage specifications and sticking to the style guide and colour scheme provided by the interior designers.
